Hairstyles must be clean, well kept, and groomed in a fashion that does not distract from the learning for both young men and women.

No symbols or words should be cut or dyed into the hair. No MOHAWK cuts. No Mullet cuts. No bizarre or trendy haircuts are allowed. Streaking or changing hair to an unnatural, distracting color or style is not allowed.

HAIR STYLES - NO SHAVED SIDES. THE DIFFERENCE IN TOP AND SIDES CAN BE NO LARGER THAN 1/2".

Hair for young men may not hit the collar of the shirt, must be out of the eyes and must be cut over the top of the ear. Tucking long hair behind the ear will not be acceptable when trying to meet these guidelines.

Young men must be clean-shaven every day. Sideburns may not extend past the middle of the ear.
